In the heart of Downtown Boston,
Armenian Heritage Park on The Greenway

The Park's geometric features tell the story of the immigrant experience.





The Abstract Sculpture,
a split rhomboid dodecahedron,
is annually reconfigured, symbolic of all
who pulled away or were forced to pull away
from their country of origin and
came to these shores to start a new life.

Annually, the two halves of the split rhomboid dodecahedron are pulled apart by a crane and reconfigured to create a new sculptural shape.

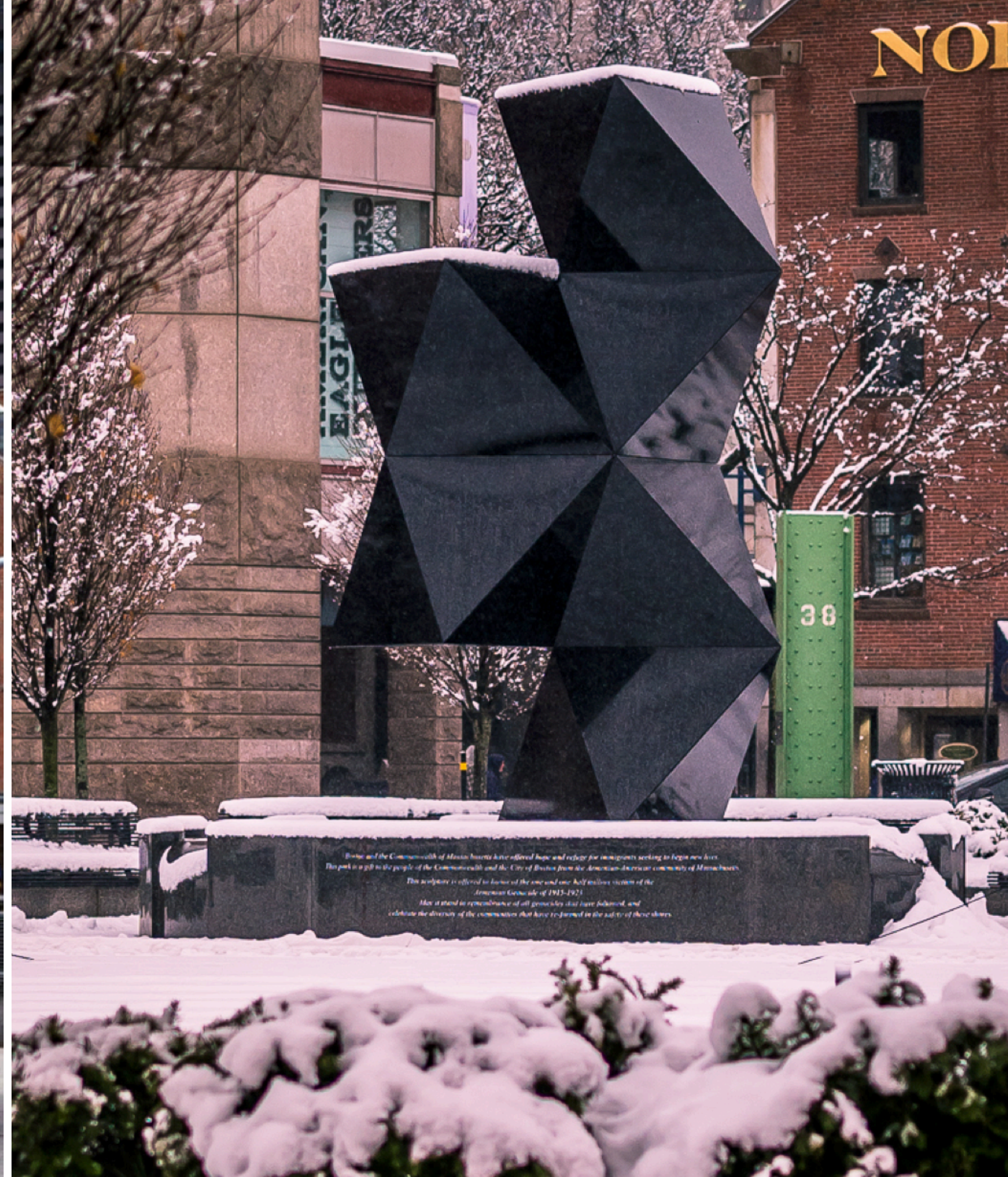
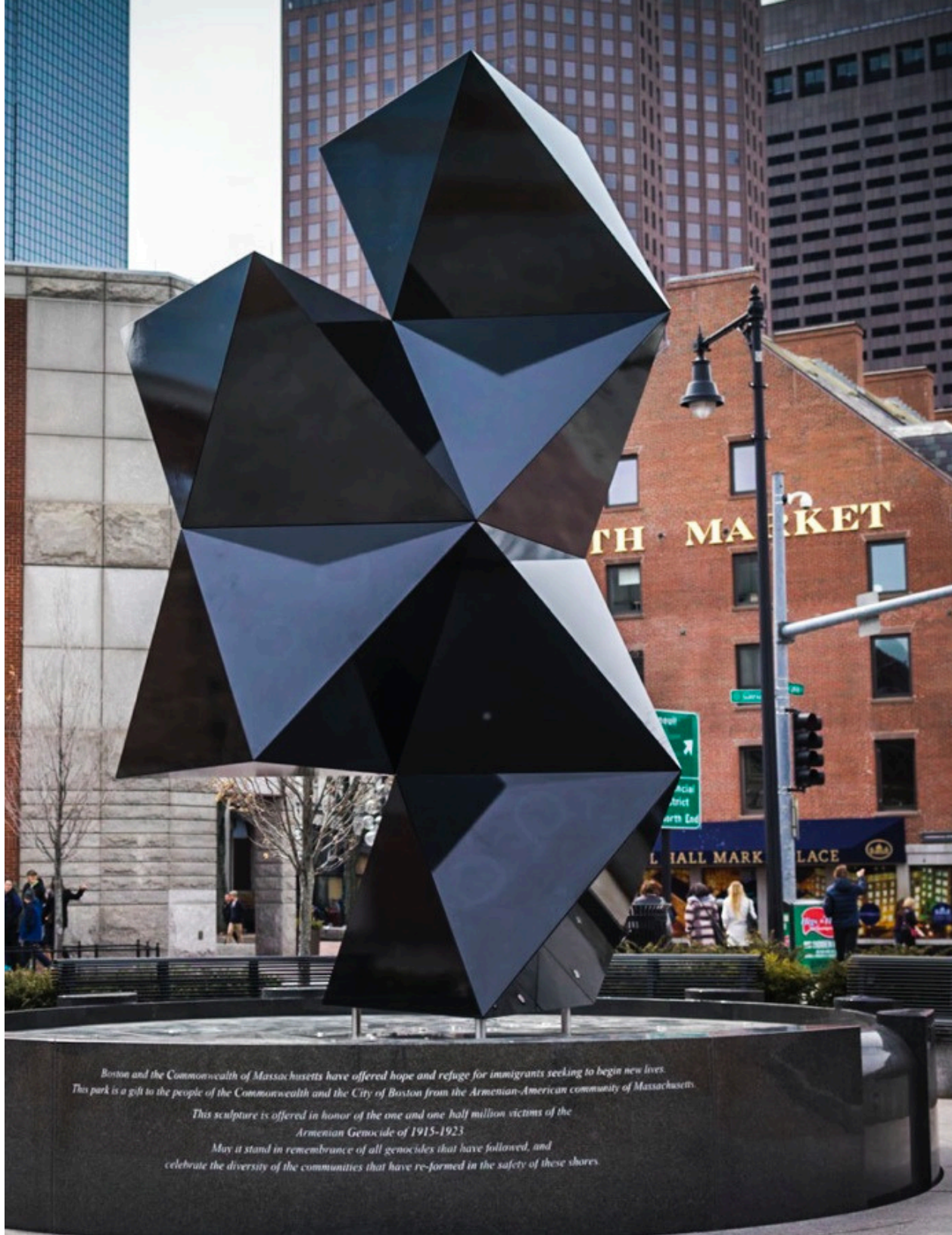

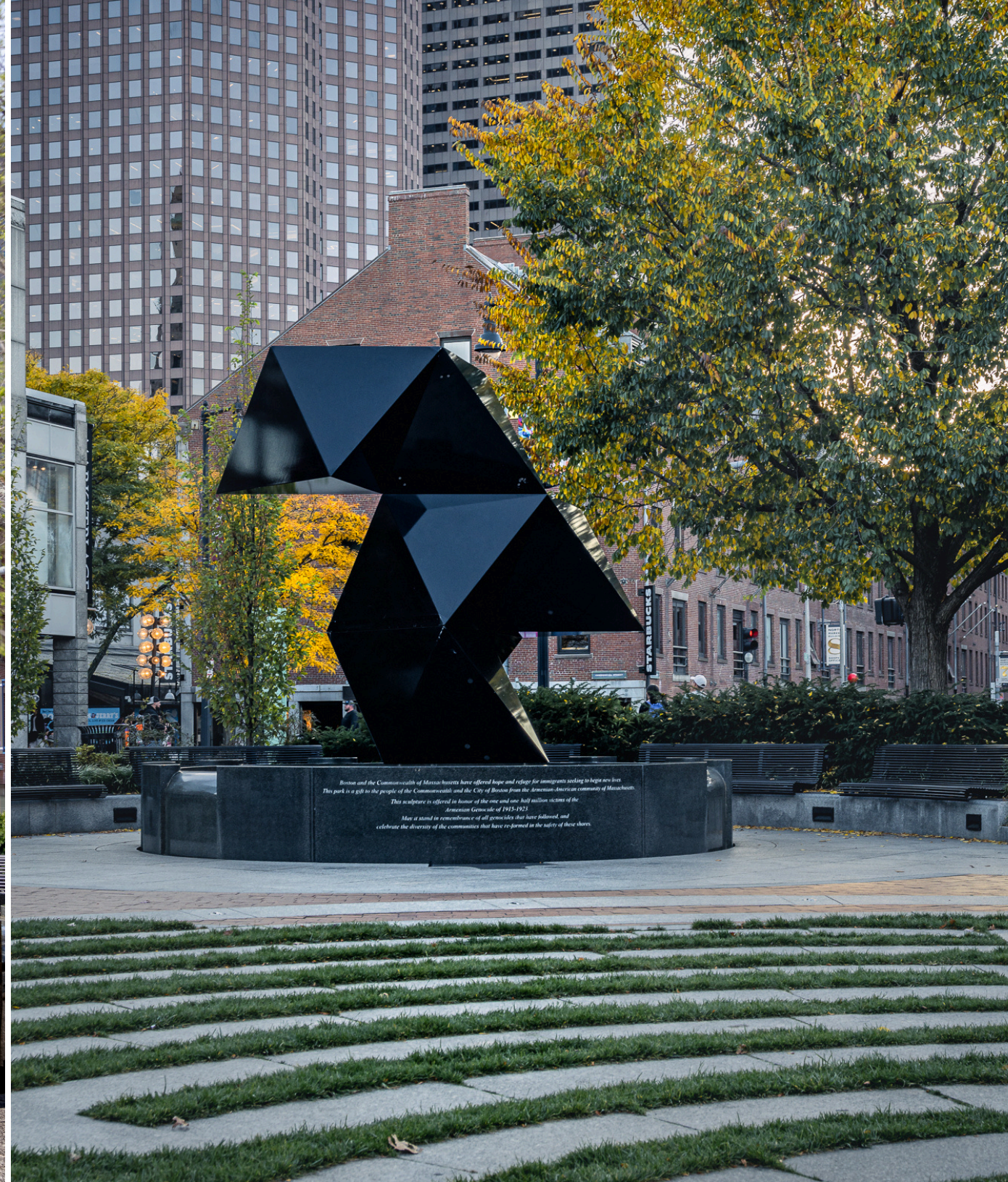
